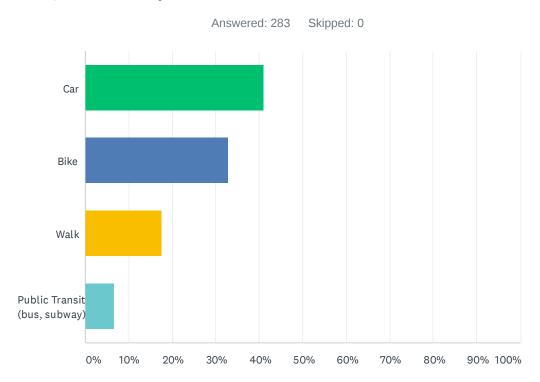
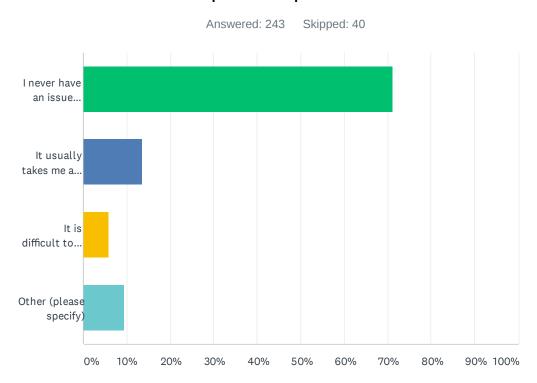
Q1 How do you travel to the Druid Hill Park Pool?

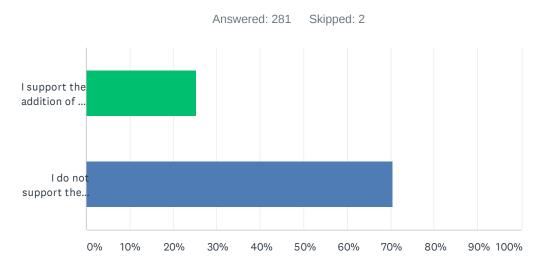
